

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WHAT IS A NEONATAL NURSE PRACTITIONER?

A neonatal nurse practitioner (NNP) is a registered nurse with advanced education and certification in diagnosing and treating illnesses and with clinical expertise in neonatal medical care.

NNPs receive a formal education with supervised clinical experience in the care of newborns. They manage newborn patients with consultation and collaboration with a medical doctor. Using their acquired knowledge of pathophysiology, pharmacology, and physiology, NNPs exercise independent judgment in the assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of infants and in the performance of certain delegated procedures. NNPs also focus on prevention, wellness, and education.
