The new building is beautiful, with an infusion center that features a beautiful fireplace and 12 treatment areas. Spacious windows allow natural light to fill the room and provide clear views to a healing garden and surrounding natural landscape. In addition to Cancer Navigation, Palliative Care and Integrative Health Services are now at Beebe

Cancer Navigation is a nursing-directed service that provides one-on-one assistance to patients from the earliest aspects of their care, screening and diagnosis, through treatment, recovery, and long-term follow-up. As a partner, Beebe Healthcare understands our responsibility to assist our patients, their caregivers and their families through all of this, and we have done so through a navigation program developed by Beebe Healthcare Oncology Services nearly a decade ago. Service over the past year to include a Breast Health Nurse Navigator, GI Navigator, and Thoracic, Head, and Neck Navigator.

Physician-supervised outpatient Palliative Care Services are now available on-site at Tunnell Cancer Center. Palliative Care aims to relieve suffering and improve the quality of life by preventing or treating, as early as possible, the symptoms and side effects of advanced cancer and its treatment, in addition to any related practical, psychological, social, and spiritual needs. Unlike hospice, Palliative Care is provided as part of a person's cancer treatment care plan.
