ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY
ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS 2018-2019

Policy: Based on the cohort the student chooses, the following must be completed prior to beginning the First Year Nursing courses:

UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE (UD) STUDENTS

1. The Preadmission ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
 - Exempt GPA 2.0 with twelve (12) credits and at least one (1) Science course
2. **College courses with a passing grade:**
 - Human Anatomy (NURS 101)*
 - Human Physiology (BISC 276)*

*These courses must have been taken within five years of the student's August enrollment.

Anatomy and Physiology can each be repeated one time to achieve a passing grade.

- Critical Reading and Writing (ENGL 110)
- Medical Microbiology (MEDT 270)
- College Math and Statistics (MATH 114)
- Introduction to Sociology (SOC 201)
- General Psychology (PSYC 100)
- Life Span Development (HDFS 201)
- Language of Medicine (MEDT 200)

Within the last 5 years only two of these college courses can be repeated one time to achieve the University of Delaware passing grade.

DTCC/TRANSFER COHORT

1. The ATI Preadmission Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
 - Performance at proficient level is required. Only one testing opportunity is provided for the student to test at the proficient level.
 - Fourteen (14) college credits must be completed before taking the ATI TEAS test.
 - The ATI TEAS test must be taken prior to April 1st of the planned August enrollment.
2. **College courses with a B or better:**

Anatomy & Physiology I & II– must have been taken within five years of the student's August enrollment.

Anatomy & Physiology I and II can each be repeated one time to achieve a grade of B or better.

3. College courses with a C or better:
 - English Composition
 - Microbiology
 - College Math and Statistics
 - Sociology
 - General Psychology
 - Human Development
 - Medical Terminology

Within the last 5 years only two of these college courses can be repeated one time to achieve a grade of C or better.

All college courses must be completed prior to the August enrollment.

Any exception(s) to this policy must be approved by the Faculty Organization.

It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they complete all the enrollment requirements.
